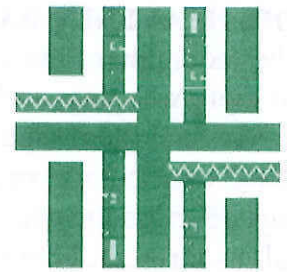

I used to think of Jonah's story as a dark tale of God punishing Jonah for not doing as he was told. When I reread it recently, however, I saw it in a totally different light. In fact, God goes to great lengths to get Jonah's attention and give him another chance. Spending three days in the belly of a fish gave him a chance to think and to pray—and to change. I think God has ways of getting my attention too. When I fly off the handle at my children, for instance, it nearly always means that something needs to change—my response to their behavior is a signal to me. It is the large fish, big and ugly and scary, that leads me back to love of God. God, you always offer me another chance. He me to jump at it every time!
