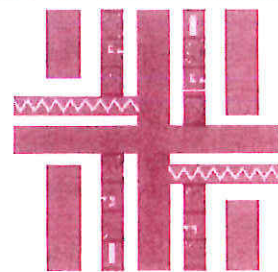

Nostalgia's nice, but the pressing questions raised by this story are still integral to the faith of mature Christians. How far will we go to get Jesus' attentions? We often meet God where it's most convenient for us, like in church on Sunday, but we sometimes forego the hard work of climbing metaphorical trees or opening wide the doors of our homes to his presence.
