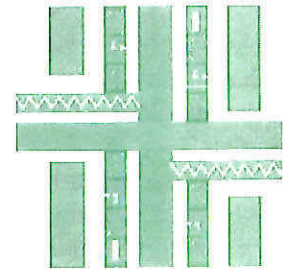

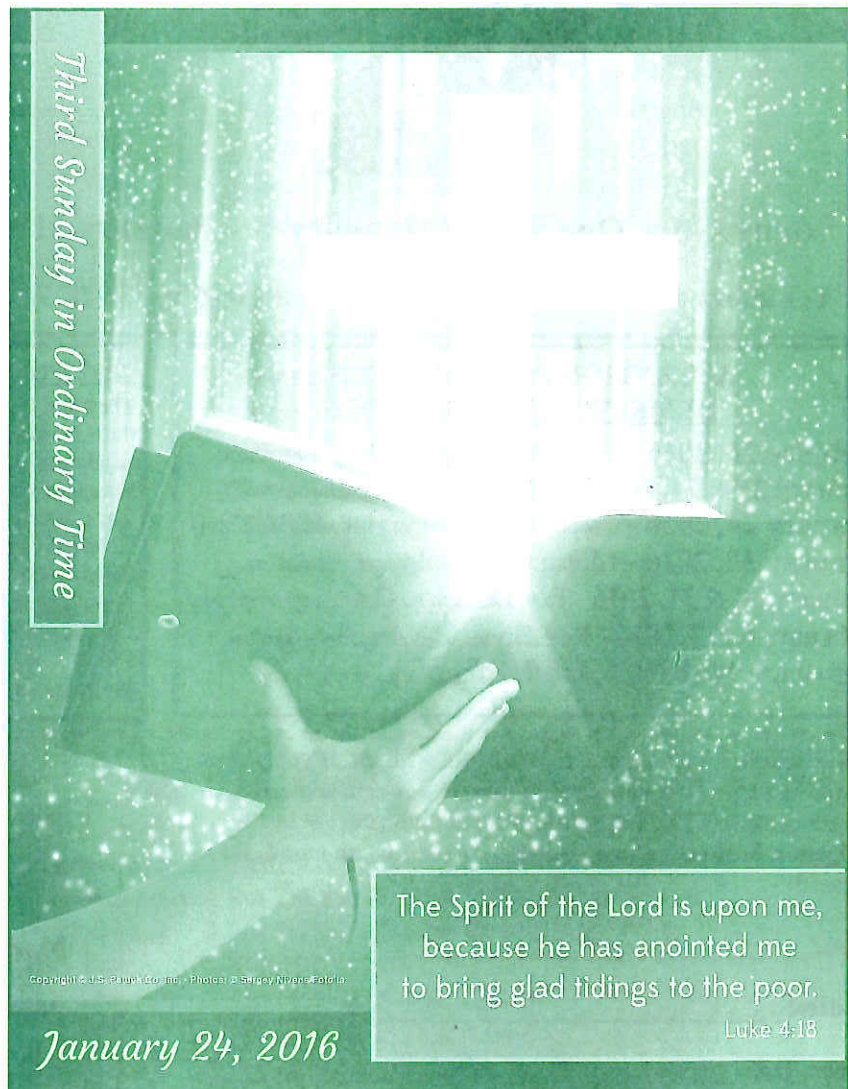

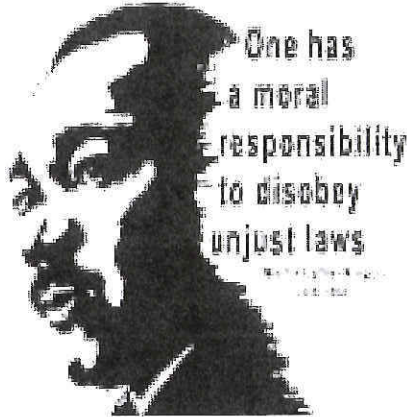
## LIVING AS THE BODY OF CHRIST
