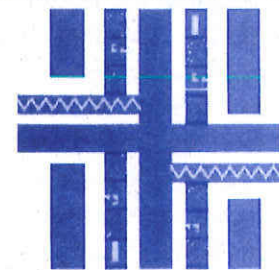

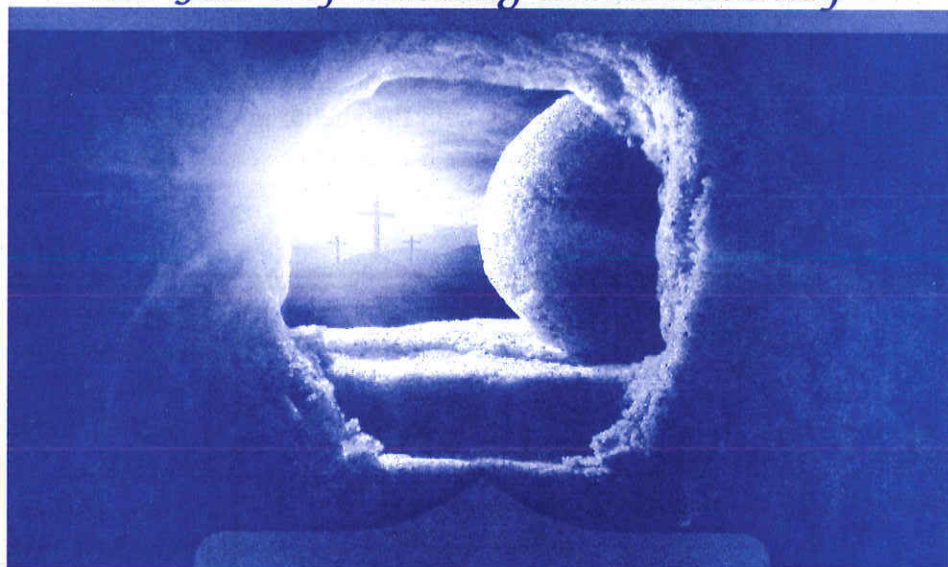

BELIEVING IN JESUS CHRIST

Throughout the Easter season, all three of the Sunday readings are taken from the New Testament--the Christian scriptures. Together they explore what it means to believe in Jesus as the Christ, the One who fulfilled the prophecies of the Jewish scriptures.

Today's selections refer to our human weakness, yet they emphasize the forgiveness and peace that are available to those who put their faith in "Jesus Christ the righteous one" (1 John 2:2). In the Acts of the Apostles Peter invites everyone to "repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away" (Acts 3:19). The First Letter of John calls Jesus Christ "expiation for our sins" (1 John 2:2). Finally, in the Gospel Jesus greets the disciples with "Peace" and urges them to preach "repentance, for the forgiveness of sins" (Luke 24:47).

Today's Good News ~Living with Christ

When I read these first chapters of Luke's gospel, I can't help but compare and contrast. On the one hand, there's Zechariah—John the Baptist's father—being stuck mute in the temple, a grand, glorious place where only a few could encounter God in a hidden, privileged center. And to the north, a young, unknown woman in a backwater held in contempt by anyone who bothered to think about it, was being touched by God. That moment was hidden, too, but would soon become anything but, as this young woman's son announced the good news of salvation for all—and the temple veil was split as he announced this same good news with the shedding of his blood. Mary asked it, but I can't help but ask it in another sense. How can this be? Who are we that God loves—all of us—so?

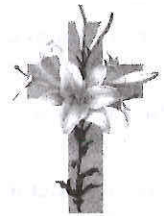
